If you live in a part of Rheinhessen called Wonnegau and are called Weinreich, the production of fine wines becomes a sacred duty. The young and committed Marc Weinreich who's been holding sway at his parental estate for a few years now, is completely up for it. But he's no revolutionary iconoclast. On the contrary, he returns to ancestral methods: organic farming of the vineyards, exclusively manual labour and a very careful handling of must and wine. Concentrating on what is important is one of Marc Weinreich's maxims, the range of wines is thus small and clear – but they've all got it what it takes!
